Requests will be accepted before and throughout the meeting and staff will call you back at the appropriate time. Once items are considered by the City Council, no further public comment on that matter will be accepted. A time limit of 3-minutes is set for all public comments.

 - a. City Council Minutes of January 19, 2021, to be received and filed.
 - b. <u>Register of Audited Demands</u> in the amount of \$1,602,082.89, dated January 7, 2021, and in the amount of \$219,359.78, dated January 14, 2021, *approval recommended by the Interim Finance Director.*
 - c. Parcel Map No. 76069; La Verne Landing (WF Construction Inc.); Subdivision Performance Bond, and Subdivision Labor Material Bond Reductions WF Construction, the developer of the La Verne Landing Apartments (Parcel Map No. 76069), an apartment building at the northwest corner of "G" and 1st Streets has requested the reduction of their Subdivision Performance Bond. Staff has inspected and verified that all work has been completed.

City Engineer Milano recommends that the City Council authorize the reduction of the Subdivision Performance Bond required for Parcel Map No. 76069 to 10 percent of the value, and authorizes the City Clerk to release the remaining 10 percent to be withheld one-year following this reduction.

d. Staff recommends approval and passage of the following Resolution (s):

Resolution No. 21-06 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE DECLARING THAT WEEDS, BRUSH, RUBBISH AND REFUSE UPON OR IN FRONT OF SPECIFIED PROPERTY IN THE CITY ARE A SEASONAL AND RECURRENT PUBLIC NUISANCE, AND DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO PROVIDE FOR THE ABATEMENT THEREOF.

Each year, the County of Los Angeles Department of Agricultural Commissioner/Weights & Measures conducts inspections for weeds, brush, rubbish, and refuse on public and private property that may be considered a seasonal and recurrent nuisance. A list of properties is provided to the City for review. City Council is then required to declare its intention to provide for this abatement and set a public hearing for affected property owners to register objections to said abatement. (Mayor Pro Tem Carder will declare a conflict of interest because she is a member of the Board of Directors for a homeowners' association that oversees property appearing on the weed abatement list).

Assistant City Clerk Estrella recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 21-06, declaring the intention to provide for the abatement of weeds, brush, rubbish, and refuse and setting a public hearing for Tuesday, February 16, 2021, at 6:30 p.m.

6. **PUBLIC HEARING**

Relocation of 2109 White Avenue House and Bungalow to 2321 First Street, Case Number 127-20RLP - The Community Development Department has received a request from the applicant, Linda Lockhart Wilkinson, requesting City Council approval to relocate the home and bungalow located at 2109 White Avenue to 2321 First Street. NOTE: Council Member Davis will declare a conflict of interest and abstain from voting on this matter because he has an ownership interest in properties located at 2411 and 2425 First Street within the vicinity of the subject property.)

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

The City Council, after conducting the public hearing, should approve the relocation of the home and bungalow located at 2109 White Avenue to 2321 First Street and adopt Resolution Number 21-07,

Resolution No. 21-07 - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING CASE NO. 127-20RLP, A RELOCATION PERMIT TO MOVE THE HOUSE AND BUNGALOW LOCATED AT 2109 WHITE AVENUE TO 2321 FIRST STREET.

<u>3rd Quarter Sales Tax Financial Update</u> - The 2020-21 Budget was approved by the City Council on June 30, 2020. Budget assumptions were incorporated into the budget based on the 2019-20 fourth quarter economic ramifications of COVID-19 known at that time. As part of the budget adoption, City staff planned to come back to the City Council with updates at approximately three-month intervals.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

The City Council should receive and file this staff report. Budget adjustments reflecting these new projections will be brought back as part of the mid-year adjustments in March.
