The San Gabriel Valley Water Quality Authority (WQA) is seeking the City Council's support to restore limited Congressional earmarks. The attached resolution and accompanying letters detail the importance of the earmarks, their critical role in past projects, along with benefits provided to the region through their use.

Deputy Public Works Director Ciotti recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 20-12, expressing the City of La Verne's support for the restoration of limited congressional earmarks and the accompanying letters that will forwarded to our Senate and Congressional representatives.

7. OTHER MATTERS

a. <u>Bowdoin Street at Williams Avenue Reopening</u> - The Community Development Department received an application proposing the development of 42 single-family homes at 2820 Amherst Street. During the review and comment period for the project, the City received comments indicating support for, and opposition to, the reopening of the Bowdoin Street intersection at Williams Avenue. The Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) prepared for the project found that the proposed project does not have any bearing on the reopening of this intersection. Therefore, any consideration regarding the reopening of Bowdoin Street at Williams Avenue is not warranted as part of the project and if desired, should be a separate deliberation of the City Council.

Staff Recommendation:

The City Council should consider the following alternative actions:

- 1. Maintain the status quo.
- 2. Direct staff to conduct additional traffic studies and report findings to Council.
- b. Mayor Hepburn has requested an item be placed on the Agenda for Council to discuss allowing the public to be included on video during the Council meetings.
