Ordinance No. 1099 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CHANGING THE ZONE DESIGNATION FROM "PR3D" TO "SPECIFIC PLAN" AND ADOPTING THE "AMHERST SPECIFIC PLAN" FOR THE SITE LOCATED AT 2820 AMHERST STREET (8666-021-902) AND A PORTION OF THE ADJACENT PARCEL, 8666-021-904 IN THE CITY OF LA VERNE.

- Amherst Housing Development, 2820 Amherst Street - Request to Construct 42 Detached Single-Family Homes - The applicant, Matt Waken with MJW Investments, LLC, is proposing to develop 42 single-family homes at 2820 Amherst Street (8666-021-902) and a portion of the adjacent parcel, 8666-021-904, both City owned properties. The properties are currently zoned PR3D and are designated Low Density Residential in the General Plan. Staff and the Development Review Committee (DRC) recommend approval of the Amherst Housing Development Project.

Community Development Director Scherer recommended approval of Ordinance No. 1099, changing the zone designation and adopting the "Amherst Specific Plan" for the Amherst Housing Development Project.

#### 6. **PUBLIC HEARINGS**

a. <u>2021-22 Paramedic Service Fee</u> - The City's voter approved Paramedic Service Fee requires an annual hearing in order to consider a rate change. The monthly fee is subject to an annual adjustment for a rate change based on the Consumer Price Index.

### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

The City Council should adjust the monthly paramedic service fee from \$5.54 to \$5.58 by adopting Resolution No. 21-22.

b. Proposed Short-Term Rental Ordinance - The City Council held a Short-Term Rental (STR) Study Session on December 20, 2020, to discuss the draft ordinance. In January of 2020, the City Council adopted a moratorium on short-term rentals (less than 30 days) based on concerns raised at various locations within the City. After several extensions, the moratorium is set to expire on August 17, 2021. Staff has drafted an ordinance to regulate short-term rentals based on the input that City Council and the Planning Commission provided. Staff and the Planning Commission recommend that the City Council adopt Ordinance No. 1098, approving new regulations for short-term rentals.

### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

The City Council should approve, waive further reading and place on first reading Ordinance No. 1098, approving new regulations for short-term rentals, as follows:

Ordinance No. 1098 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE LA VERNE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 18.94 TO REGULATE THE RENTAL OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY ON A SHORT- TERM BASIS AND AMENDING RELATED PROVISIONS.

#### 7. OTHER MATTERS

<u>Temporary Employment Agreement - Resolution No. 21-23</u> - Interim Fire Chief David Segura has provided notification he will be leaving his position effective as soon as possible. After conducting a search of qualified replacements, Lawrence Waterhouse has been selected to serve as Interim Fire Chief while the City concludes recruitment for a permanent replacement. In order to be compliant with the 2013 Pension Reform Act, it is necessary for the City Council to take an action affirming the execution of such employment arrangements. The resolution and agreement satisfies that requirement.

## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

The City Council should approve Resolution No, 21-23, authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with Lawrence Waterhouse to provide temporary, part-time employment.

ADJOURNMENT in memory of Jefferson Hill Sr, a long-time La Verne resident who 11. passed away on Friday, April 16, 2021. Mr. Hill was born on May 19, 1935, in Lake City, Tennessee. In 2003, Mr. Hill established the La Verne/San Dimas Meals on Wheels Program when he saw an unmet need for this service in both cities. The program started with seven recipients, and today serves over 50 meals daily. He served in the Air Force for twenty-two (22) years as a Senior Master Sergeant during both the Korean and Vietnam Wars. He was a lifetime member of the VFW and is a past post-commander. He was instrumental in the campaign to construct the La Verne Veterans Memorial. In 2015, he was recognized by Assembly Member Holden for his years of services to his Country serving in the Air Force and the community. He was named Veteran of the Year for the 41st Assembly District. He worked for Northrop as an aerospace engineer, earned a Masters in Psychology and went on to teach at several colleges. In 2015, he received the 50<sup>th</sup> Annual Older American Recognition Day Award. For his service to the community and commitment to the Veterans, he was honored as a Community Hero at the Los Angeles County Fair in 2015. His biggest passion was helping his fellow Veterans. He is survived by his wife Helen, his sons Jefferson Jr, Charles and daughter Evelyn.
