Presentation on the SB 1383 and AB 1594 New Regulations Regarding Refuse and Green Waste - Cara Morgan from Cal Recycle will give a presentation on SB 1383 - A Statewide effort to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants (SLCP) that will require cities to reduce organic waste disposal 50% by 2020 and 75% by 2025.

Lisa O'Brien Senior Management Analyst will gave a presentation on the Implementation of SB 1383 in La Verne and Tracy Costello, Public Works Manager will give report on the Waste Management's proposed Refuse Increases.

## c. Staff recommends approval and passage of the following Resolutions:

1. Resolution No. 21-24 - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING AN INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITY REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE PUBLIC FINANCING AUTHORITY OF THE LA VERNE ENHANCED INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCING DISTRICT. At the City Council's February 16, 2021 Study Session, staff presented funding alternatives for initial projects outlined in the Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District's (District) Infrastructure Financing Plan (IFP). The Council provided direction to discuss the alternatives with the Public Financing Authority (PFA) with a recommendation that the City provide the initial funding with a reimbursement agreement with the PFA. The PFA met on March 10, 2021, and agreed with the approach, directing Staff to prepare such an agreement.

Community Development Director Scherer recommends that the City Council approve Resolution 21-24, approving the draft Infrastructure and Facility Reimbursement Agreement which outlines the priority projects between the City and the PFA, with the PFA scheduled to review and approve the agreement at their June 9, 2021 meeting.

2. Resolution No. 21-26 - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO APPROVE THE ANNUAL REPORT OF THE OLD TOWN LA VERNE BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT WHICH INCLUDES A BUDGET AND REESTABLISHES THE BOUNDARIES AND ASSESSMENT FORMULA FOR THE 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR AND SETS A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE MATTER - An annual public hearing is required to consider the Annual Report of the Old Town La Verne Business Improvement District (OTLVBID) and it has been scheduled for June 7, 2021. At said hearing, the City Council will be requested to 1) Receive and file a report of the OTLVBID prior year activities. 2) Approve the proposed OTLVBID 2021-2022 Annual Budget and incorporate it into the City Budget. 3) Approve reestablishment of the District boundaries and assessment formula.

Community Development Director Scherer recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No.21-26 declaring its intention to approve the OTLVBID Annual Report and sets a public hearing on the matter for June 7, 2021.

#### 7. PUBLIC HEARINGS

<u>2021- Comprehensive Fee Schedule</u> - The City's Comprehensive Fee Schedule was established by Resolution 17-23 and as amended by Resolutions 18-19, 19-23 and 20-37, is reviewed each year in conjunction with the annual budget process. Adjustments are made to reflect changes in the cost of services in accordance with State and local law. Resolution 21-25 provides for adjustments to the 2021-22 Comprehensive Fee Schedule.

## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Following the public hearing, the City Council should approve the updates to the City's Comprehensive Fee Schedule as set forth in resolution 21-25. All fee schedule changes are scheduled to become effective July 1, 2021, except Building and Planning Department fees, which by State Law become effective 60 days after City Council approval. The refuse fees are subject to approval after the Proposition 218 hearing on June 21, 2021.

RESOLUTION NO. 21-25 - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTIONS NO. 17-23, 18-19,19-23 & 20-37 RELATIVE TO CERTAIN FEES AND POLICIES FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF LA VERNE.

#### 8. OTHER MATTERS

<u>Proposed Short-Term Rental Ordinance</u> - At the Council's May 3, 2021 meeting, a public hearing was conducted and concluded. The Ordinance document required minor technical changes and is being brought back to the Council at this meeting with the recommendation to waiver further reading, and introduce. The Ordinance will take effect on August 17, 2021, when the current moratorium expires.

## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

The City Council should waive further reading and place on first reading Ordinance No. 1098, approving new regulations for short-term rentals, as follows:

Ordinance No. 1098 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE LA VERNE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING A NEW CHAPTER 18.94 TO REGULATE THE RENTAL OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY ON A SHORT-TERM BASIS AND AMENDING RELATED PROVISIONS.
