d. Ordinance (s) Second Reading, as follows:

Ordinance No. 1102 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE. COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES. STATE OF CALIFORNIA. ESTABLISHING A PRE-ANNEXATION ZONING DESIGNATION FROM THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY ZONING OF A-1-15000 TO PR3D (HDOZ) AND ADOPTING THE PR3D (HDOZ) ZONING FOR 500 BASELINE ROAD (8666-006-035) IN THE CITY OF LA VERNE - Ramzy Fakhoury (Applicant) submitted an application for a number of entitlements including annexation of an approximate 19.44 acre site, located at 500 Baseline Road (8666-006-035) currently within unincorporated Los Angeles County into the City of La Verne. A General Plan Amendment to utilize the Low Density General Plan Land Use designation, a Vesting Tentative Tract Map 082001 for subdivision of a 19.44 acre property into nine lots including seven single-family lots, one debris basin lot and one open space lot, a Vesting Tentative Tract Map 082001 for subdivision of a 19.44 acre property into nine lots including seven single-family lots, one debris basin lot and one open space lot, a zone change from the Los Angeles County zoning designation of A-1-15000 to PR3D, HDOZ (Hillside Development Overlay) Zone were required. The City Council on September 20, 2021, adopted Resolution No. 21-71 approving a Mitigated Negative Declaration, adopting a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, adopted Resolution No. 21-72 for annexation of the property into the City of La Verne from the County of Los Angeles; adopted Resolution 21-73 changing the General Plan Land Use designation of the property to Low Density Residential; and placed on first reading Ordinance No. 1102, establishing a pre-annexation designation from the County of Los Angeles zoning to City zoning.

Staff, the Development Review Committee (DRC) and the Planning Commission recommend that the City Council approve Ordinance No, 1102, establishing a pre-annexation zoning designation from the County of Los Angeles zoning of A-1-15000 to PR3D (HDOZ) and adopting PR3D (HDOZ) zoning for 500 Baseline Road.

<u>La Verne Municipal Code 2.04.020 Regarding City Manager Residency</u> - The City Council, at its June 7, 2021 meeting, requested that the residency requirement code section come back for review following research into the practices of other cities and the applicable law. The City Attorney's Office is seeking direction from the Council.

The City Council should review the information provided and give direction to the City Attorney's Office.
