 - a. <u>City Council Minutes</u> of the adjourned and regular meetings of October 18, 2021, *to be received and filed.*
 - b. <u>Register of Audited Demands</u> in the amount of \$1,771,757.18 dated October 14, 2021, and in the amount of \$289,027.68, dated October 21, 2021, *approval recommended by Finance Director Pendleton.*
 - c. <u>Filming Agreement for Shadowboxer Films</u> The proposed filming agreement will permit Shadowboxer Films to film at the University of La Verne. They are requesting filming and ancillary activities to be permitted on multiple dates totaling nine beginning November 2, 2021, and concluding on November 14, 2021.

Assistant to the City Manager Ranells recommends that the City Council approve the filming agreement with Shadowboxer Films and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement.

- d. Staff recommends approval and passage of the following Resolutions:
 - 1. <u>Resolution No. 21-86</u>- A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF INDUSTRY FOR THE EXCHANGE OF PROPOSITION A FUNDS FOR GENERAL FUND REVENUES In September, the City approached the City of Industry informing them that the City was interested in exchanging uncommitted Proposition A Transportation Funds for General Fund monies. The City of Industry agreed to the exchange at a rate of .75 per dollar in general fund monies per \$1.00 in Proposition A Funds.

Community Services Manager Duran recommends that the City Council approve Resolution No. 21-86, authorizing an exchange of \$300,000 in Proposition A Transportation Funds for \$225,000 of General Funds with the City of Industry and to authorize the City Manager to execute said Agreement. 2. <u>Resolution No. 21-87</u> - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING INVESTMENT POLICY FOR PUBLIC FUNDS AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 06-04 - To ensure the guideline of temporary idle cash is managed consistently with the Government Code and the conservative investment philosophy of the City Council to maximize investment while safeguarding the assets of the City, the Investment Policy has been reviewed and updated.

Finance Director Pendleton recommends that the City Council approve Resolution No. 21-87, adopting an Investment Policy for public funds and rescinding existing Resolution No. 06-04, and incorporate all changes to update Administrative Regulation Number 216.

e. Ordinance (s), First Reading, approval recommended for the following:

<u>Ordinance No. 1105</u> - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, REPEALING LA VERNE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.04.020 REGARDING RESIDENCE AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR CITY MANAGER. The City Council became aware of a provision in the City's Municipal Code regarding a residency requirement for the City Manager and based on that requirement, the City's current City Manager was out of compliance. After completing a comprehensive review of information on other area municipalities and contemplating what would best serve the City going forward, the City Council directed staff to prepare an ordinance repealing the residency requirement code section as well as rescind the Notice for the City Manager to comply.

Assistant to the City Manager Ranells recommends that the City Council waive further reading and place on first reading Ordinance No. 1105, repealing Municipal Code Section 2.04.020 regarding Residence and Eligibility requirements for City Manager and to rescind the Notice provided to the City Manager on June 7, 2021, to comply with the code section being repealed.

f. Ordinances, Second Reading, approval recommended for the following:

1. <u>Ordinance No. 1103</u> - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE AMENDMENT TO THE FOOTHILL BOULEVARD SPECIFIC PLAN - *The City Council at its meeting of October 18, 2021, approved the Townhome Development at 3717 Fruit Street by Brandywine Development. In conjunction with the approval of the proposed project, City Council also approved a General Plan Amendment, adding a new land use designation of specific plan-mixed use and redesignating the Fruit Street property from commercial/business park to specific plan-mixed use, thereby requiring that the Foothill Boulevard Specific Plan be amended. Ordinance No. 1103, amending the Foothill Boulevard Specific was placed on first reading on and further reading waived on October 18. 2021.*

2. Ordinance No. 1104 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE AMENDMENT TO THE WALNUT STREET SPECIFIC PLAN - The City Council at its meeting of October 18, 2021, approved the Walnut Street Affordable Home Development by Brandywine Homes Development. In conjunction with the approval of the proposed project, City Council also approved a General Plan Amendment by adding a new land use designation of specific-plan-residential and redesignating the Walnut Street properties from low density residential to specificplan residential, thereby requiring that the Walnut Street Specific Plan be amended. Ordinance No. 1104, amending the Walnut Specific Plan was placed on first reading and further reading waived on October 18. 2021.
