## 4. Police Badge Pinning Ceremony

Mark Gutierrez Promotion to Police Sergeant - Mark was born and raised in the City of La Verne. In 1993, Mark joined the La Verne Police Explorer Program where his Explorer Advisor at the time was Chief of Police Nick Paz. He began his career as a Police Officer with the City of La Verne when he graduated from the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Academy in 2004 and has been with the City of La Verne for 18 years. Mark carries a tremendous amount of care, positivity and pride serving in the City and Police Department because La Verne is his hometown. During his career, Mark has been part of a number of assignments to include patrol, field training, detective, homeless outreach, firearms instructor, tactical operator and sniper for our regional swat team. Mark was also assigned to the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) where he was federally sworn and investigated large-scale narcotic traffickers through the use of wiretap investigations. Mark is currently assigned to patrol where serves as our newest Police Sergeant. Mark has three children. His oldest is one of the City's newest Police Dispatchers. His mother will pin his badge.

Carlos Flores Promotion to Corporal - Carlos grew up in La Verne and attended Damien High School. He graduated from Cal State Los Angeles with a Bachelor's of Science degree in Finance. Upon graduation, Carlos worked in the private sector for various CPA firms in tax, audit, and financial management oversight of federally funded entities. He was hired by the La Verne Police Department in January of 2016, graduated from the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Academy in the top percentage of his class academically in July of 2016. Carlos has been a recipient of the 10851 pin for recovery of stolen vehicles and subsequent arrests of related suspects and he was twice awarded the 23152 VC pin for most drunk driving arrests. He has been involved with the Homeless Outreach Services Team (HOST), since its inception. Carlos currently serves in the capacity of Detective for the La Verne Police Department and Vice President of the La Verne Police Department Police Association. His eldest son will pin his badge.
