Old Town La Verne Business Improvement District Appointment Previous Old Town La Verne Business Improvement District (OTLVBID) Board Member Matthew Forgey, a representative of the Third Street Wine Shop elected not to seek re-appointment upon his term's expiration. The City solicited applications for the vacancy from the OTLVBID members and the general public. Only one application was received by long-term OTLVBID member and business owner George Henderson.

It is recommended by the Old Town La Verne Business Improvement District's Advisory Board that the Mayor appoint George Henderson to the vacant seat effective from this date to June 30, 2024 with the approval of the City Council.

d. Staff recommends approval and passage of the following Resolutions:

Conflict of Interest Code Resolution No. 22-73 - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A STANDARDIZED CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR DESIGNATED EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE - Every two years, the City of La Verne is required to review its Conflict of Interest Code to determine if any changes are necessary. Staff consulted with the City Attorney and Department Heads to determine necessary amendments to the list of designated filers. The changes reflected in Appendix "A" attached to Resolution No. 22-73, are the result of the following:

Assistant City Clerk Estrella recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 22-73, updating the standardized conflict of interest code for designated employees.

7. OTHER MATTERS

American Recovery Act – Small Business Rescue Program Update - At the City Council meeting held on February 22, 2022, staff presented the Small Business Rescue Program using a portion of the City's allocation of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. The program has been operating successfully since March of 2022 and has assisted over 61 businesses. Staff has been working with the Chamber of Commerce and the Small Business Development Center (SBDC) at University of La Verne (ULV) to develop an update to the program. There is also a need to redirect the remaining funds to Fire Station 1 Gender Compliance Project.

Community Development Director Scherer recommends that the City Council approve the update to the Small Business Rescue Program including:

- The business must have been mandated to shut down during the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The business has a minimum of at least one employee and does not exceed a maximum of fifty (50) full or full-time equivalent employees (two part-time employees' equal one fulltime employee).
- The number of additional grant participants will be limited to the amount of funding (up to \$100,000) allocated to the program.
- The business must submit the application, and all required supporting documentation on or before December 1, 2022.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council should approve the updates to the Small Business Rescue Program and that the City Council approve the reallocation of the remaining unused Small Business Rescue Program ARPA funds (about \$300,000), after the close of the program on December 1, 2002, to the Fire Station 1 Gender Compliance project.
