4. RESOLUTION NO. JPFA-66 & RESOLUTION NO. JPFA-67 ADOPTING BUDGETS FOR LA VERNE MOBILE COUNTRY CLUB MOBILE HOME PARK AND VALLEY RANCHO MOBILE HOME PARK - Annually, the La Verne Public Financing Authority (LVPFA) reviews and approves the operating budgets for the two LVPFA-owned mobile home parks. The budgets do not reflect significant changes from previous years and are attached for the La Verne Public Financing Authority's consideration and adoption.

Recommendation: That the City Council appoint one (1) new member to the Active Transportation Committee to complete the current term expiring on June 30, 2025.

6. AUTHORIZATION TO OFFER MONETARY REWARD IN INCIDENTS OF VIOLENT CRIME FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO ARREST AND CONVICTION - On July 1, 2023, during mid-day, Rodeo Jewelers was the scene of a violent robbery in which the suspects drove their vehicle into the store, assaulted an employee, and conducted a smash and grab robbery. This item seeks to both offer a reward for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the suspects as well as authorize the City Manager, upon recommendation of the Chief of Police, to offer a similar reward for future violent crimes.

Recommendation: That the City Council authorize a \$10,000 reward for information which leads to the arrest and conviction of the suspects involved in the Rodeo Jewelers robbery and authorize the City Manager, upon recommendation of the Chief of Police, to offer similar rewards for future violent crimes.
