Resolution No. 20-11 - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORINZG THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH MAJESTIC CYCLING FOR THE LA VERNE GRAND PRIX - The City Council is requested to consider a street closure for the La Verne Grand Prix event. Majestic Cycling has submitted a request to use portions of Wheeler Avenue, Yeager Avenue, Wright Avenue and Puddingstone Drive for a cycling race on Sunday, March 15, 2020 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 20-11, authorizing the City Manager to execute the Agreement with Majestic Cycling permitting the cycling race on specified streets.

### 6. PUBLIC HEARINGS

<u>Urgency Ordinance No. 1092 - Extension of Moratorium on Short Term Rentals</u> - At their January 21, 2020 meeting, the City Council adopted Urgency Ordinance No. 1091, a moratorium on short-term (less than 30 days) rentals due to concerns raised by residents. This moratorium will expire on March 6, 2020 unless extended by the City Council. Staff is requesting that the moratorium be extended through January 21, 2021 in order to prepare a draft ordinance to permanently regulate this use.

## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

The City Council should adopt Urgency Ordinance No. 1092 extending the moratorium of short- term (less than 30 days) rentals for a period not to extend past January 21, 2021.

Ordinance No. 1092 - AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA EXTENDING AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1091 ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM ON SHORT-TERM RENTALS OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY.
