4. Public Hearing to Consider Issuance of Tax-Exempt Obligations by California Municipal Finance Authority on behalf of Hillcrest – Pursuant to Federal law, the City Council must hold a public hearing when tax exempt obligations are proposed to be issued. The City of La Verne is not a party to the financing and would not be liable on the obligations. The obligations are being issued to refinance existing debt and to finance the construction of fourteen (14) new residences which have already been approved by the City Council. NOTE: Mayor Hepburn previously served on the Hillcrest Board of Directors and advised on the new homes to be constructed. He recused himself during Council consideration of the approval of the new homes and he will recuse himself on this issue. Mayor Pro Tem Carder will conduct the public hearing.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

The City Council should, after conducting the public hearing, adopt Resolution No. 20-29 approving the issuance of obligations (not to exceed \$50,000,000) by the California Municipal Finance Authority for the benefit of Brethren Hillcrest Homes

Resolution No. 20-29 - A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA VERNE, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF THE CALIFORNIA MUNICIPAL **FINANCE** AUTHORITY REVENUE BONDS IN ONE OR MORE SERIES IN AN AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000,000 FOR THE **PURPOSE** OF **FINANCING AND** THE REFINANCING ACQUISITION. CONSTRUCTION, **FURNISHING** AND EQUIPPING OF A SENIOR LIVING COMMUNITY FOR BRETHREN HILLCREST HOMES AND CERTAIN OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.
