3. Also, if you wish to make a comment during the meeting. We will be monitoring the email address and will make every effort to include your comment into the records. Please be aware there is a delay in the live stream service and any comments should be submitted as soon as possible.

4. **PUBLIC COMMENTS/ORAL COMMUNICATIONS** - This is the time set aside for anyone wishing to address the City Council on items not listed in any other place on the agenda. Under the provisions of the Brown Act, the legislative body is prohibited from talking or engaging in discussion on any item not appearing on the posted agenda. However, your concerns may be referred to staff or set for discussion at a later date. There is a three-minute limit per speaker. 5. **Resolution No. 20-49 - Confirming the Existence of a Local Emergency in Response to Civil Unrest** - On May 31, 2020, the City Manager acting as the Emergency Services Director as authorized by the La Verne Municipal Code proclaimed the existence of a local emergency in response to civil unrest. Government Code provides for the continuation of the proclaimed local emergency by an official designated by City ordinance. The local emergency must be ratified by City Council within seven (7) days. Staff is requesting that the City Council ratify the proclamation by approving Resolution No. 20-49, confirming the existence of a local emergency.

Staff Recommendation:

The City Council should approve Resolution No. 20-49, confirming the existence of a local emergency in response to civil unrest.
